

Albright Shores Sand Drag Rules 2006

Albright Shores races are conducted for the enjoyment of the competitors and spectators and therefore reserves the right to expel anyone conducting themselves in an unsportmanlike manner or not allowing others to enjoy the event.

Safety It is the drivers/owners responsibility to maintain the vehicle (truck, buggy, bike atv, etc.), the tracks main responsibility is to provide a safe and fun place to conduct racing, as well as the safety of all racers, spectators and track personnel. ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS OUTLINED BELOW ARE EFFECTIVE April 1, 2006.

Vehicle Inspection All vehicles participating in an Albright Shores Sand Drag Event must be inspected by a track official before the first event of the year or before the first event the vehicle is participating in. All vehicles cleared to race will be issued a Safety Check Sticker, which must be attached to the vehicle in a visible location. Final determination of suitability of any vehicle entered is the responsibility of the Albright Shores track officials. Any significant modifications to the vehicles throughout the racing season will require the vehicle to be reinspected by a track official.

Age Drivers/riders must be a minimum of 16 years of age, drivers/riders 16-18 years of age must have a parent/guardian sign a release form before each event.

Numbers All vehicles must have clearly visible (large legible) numbers on the front and right side of the vehicle. Track registration will issue numbers to all competitors

Clothing All competitors must be fully clothed, shirts must be long sleeves, pants (no shorts), socks and shoes. Some form of over the ankle boot is required for bike/ATV riders. Eye protection is required for all competitors without windshields. All forced induction, nitrous, fuel vehicles are encouraged to wear a full fire suit.

Kill Switch Tethers are required on all bikes/ATVs

Drivers Meeting All competitors are required to attend the drivers meeting before the start of each event (held at the base of the tower). Any competitor not attending may be disqualified from running that day.

Multiple Entry Any competitor may enter more than 1 class, 2 competitors can not enter the same vehicle in the same class. No competitor may enter 2 vehicles in the same class.

Lane Choice Classes line up in 4 rows. The staging official draws 2 cards (1-4), the first card drawn gets lane choice.

Bye Runs Single vehicle runs will be assigned as needed. Bye runs are optional BUT if run must be a legal pass, if run is disqualified competitor does not advance to next round. Break outs are permitted on a bye runs.

Dial In Times All dial in times must be turned in at base of the tower by time specified at drivers meeting. A written slip will be given as proof of dial time.

Ready to Race It is the competitors responsibility to be in staging and ready to race (helmet, fueled, etc.) when his class is run.

Alcohol No alcohol or drugs are allowed during the event. Drivers drinking will be disqualified.

Tower No one except track official are allowed in the tower.
